It is suggested that the participants write on a card a brief description of your dish (hot, mild, etc.) to help our people select the soup or chili of their choice. We encourage you to take advantage of this church-wide fellowship opportunity sponsored by our Hospitality Committee.

The Twilights Valentine Dinner and Program will take place on Tuesday, Feb. 14th at 6:30 p.m. in the Social Hall. The men will honor all the ladies in attendance that night.
